Articles which have developed making full use of the rich regional resources of Setouchi City. These include oyster and mamakari (Japanese sardinella) processed products, lemon confection sweets, and pottery using the clay of Sabukaze, which are great as souvenirs.









### **Agricultural Products**

Setouchi City known for its mild weather grows the largest harvest of Chinese tea leaves, cabbage, winter melon and spaghetti squash in Okayama, and the largest harvest of mushrooms in Japan. This area is also known for its lemons, mangos, grapes and oranges and is a major producer of delicious agricultural

Seafood Seafood delicacies including sawara (Spanish mackerel), mamakari (Japanese sardi-nella), sea bream, sole, sea eel, octopus and swimming crab all from the Seto Inland Sea served fresh and delicious. Ovster farms are now a flourishing industry in Okayama, especially in Mushiage where oyster farming started in Okayama Prefecture.

**Cherry Blossoms** 

Early April Around Okayama Ikoinomura,


